

Dr. Sabina Vidulin is the Head of the Department of Music Pedagogy and the leader of musical-pedagogical courses at the Academy of Music in Pula. She is the founder of the International Symposium of Music Pedagogues and the International Forum of Music Pedagogy Students. She has held over hundred lectures throughout Croatia and abroad at recognized music academies: from the Salzburg's Mozarteum, Vienna's MDW, the Royal Conservatory in The Hague, to music academies in Germany, Belgium, Poland, Italy, Lithuania, Latvia, Czech Republic, Hungary, Cyprus, Sweden, Slovenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Monte Negro, Serbia and in the USA. She wrote five books, fourteen chapters in books, about seventy scientific papers published in Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Slovenia, Italy, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Poland and Lithuania, and USA. She is the editor of a songbook, five symposia proceedings, and two monographs. Vidulin is a

member of editorial boards in six international scientific journals, a member of the publishing committee of the publisher Helbling (Innsbruck-Esslingen-Bern-Belp), and the national coordinator for the European Association for Music in Schools. She is involved in the organization of international symposia in Croatia and abroad as a member of scientific committees. She is also working at the Academy of Music in Sarajevo. Vidulin received the State Award Ivan Filipović and the award from the Croatian Society of Music and Dance Pedagogues.
